Rules and regulations

1.I International Homebrew Competition is organized by Silesian Department of Polskie Stowarzyszenie Piwowarów Domowych (Polish Homebrewers Association) represented by Jan Krysiak and Adam Wróbel.

Competition will take place on **29-06-2014** in „Górnośląski Park Etnograficzny w Chorzowie” museum in Chorzów between **13:00** and **16:00**.

2.Volker Quante will be a competition’s jury chairman. The competition is to be held in accordance with the Best Practice Rules for PSPD Homebrew Competitions. Results of the competition will be included in the PSPD Cup classification for season 2014/2015.

3.Competition will be limited to the following BJCP styles:

Octoberfest	BJCP 3B
Bock	BJCP 5B
Dry Stout	BJCP 15A
Strong Bitter	BJCP8C

4.Entrant may entry only one brew in each category. Entrant must be at least 18 years old.

5.The entry fee is:

- 10 PLN for each entry for PSPD members
- 12 PLN for each entry for non PSPD members
- 3 EUR for each entry for foreigners

7.Entrant is obligated to fill out one entry form for each entry. Bottles may have an identifying label attached with a rubber band (no tape or glue). Labeled bottle caps are allowed.

Entries must arrive no later than **23-06-2014** and not earlier than **09-06-2014**. Three (3) 0,5 liter or five (5) 0,33 liter bottles must be delivered to the following address:

8.Entries will be judged anonymously. All entries will be coded before the competition. If more than 12-15 entries per category are received the qualification round will take place.

9.Winners will be announced right after the competition All entrants that will reach the final round will receive the score sheets with judges' comments for their entries. Score sheets will be mailed after the competition.

10. The organizer reserves the right to publish full name of all entrants that will reach the final round.

11. Diplomas and prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each category

12. Authors of the winning entries may be asked to publish their recipe.

13. The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations in case of urgent or unpredicted matters.
